Dear Parents

As you will know the residential to Kingswood approaching! Everyone involved is looking forward to getting there, where I'm sure fun will be had by all. However, there are a few additional items that you need to know before your child embarks on their adventure.

Your child will need to be at school at the normal time (8:40 to 8:50am) on Monday morning. All luggage should be placed in the hall when children arrive. Please ensure that your child has had their breakfast as usual before school. It will be a good idea to send your child with a snack to keep them going until they have their lunch at Kingswood. Please do not send sweets!

For health and safety reasons it is very important that the snack is packed in a plastic/paper bag and drinks are provided in disposable plastic bottles or cartons, so we can dispose of all the packaging and waste when we arrive at Kingswood. Please do not send the snack in a lunchbox.

The coach is due to return to school by the end of the school day on the Wednesday. If it appears that the coach will be delayed we will use our texting system to inform parents via their mobile phones.

Kit list

- Several warm tops with long sleeves
- Waterproof Jacket
- Wellington boots (if available)
- Fleece Jacket
- Tracksuit bottoms (NOT JEANS)
- Pyjamas
- Socks and underwear
- Washing kit and towel including toothbrush and paste. Spare towel for wet activities
- Hat and gloves for cold weather
- Old trainers for wet activities
- Plastic bag to take wet kit home in
- Drinks bottle
- Pocket money (recommended £5 max)

Please remember to pack lots of layers and send plenty of underwear / socks. Last year we had a spell of particularly cold and wet weather and we found that children needed to change out of wet clothes frequently. Old clothes are best –the children spend the much of their time outdoors – last year sometimes wading through puddles and mud!
