## Uniform Expectations

We are very proud of our school uniform at Chetwynd. As many of you will be purchasing new uniform over the summer holidays we would like to remind you of our uniform expectations. (Those of you with children at George Spencer School will have received a similar note about their uniform too).

A list of our uniform is given below but can we draw you attention to the following points in particular:

- Please ensure that girls are wearing **skirts of an appropriate length**. We are finding that more and more girls are wearing shorts skirts that really are inappropriate for school – it is not a fashion show; these are work clothes. Any girls who breach these expectations will be sanctioned. In more extreme cases we will contact parents to make arrangements to collect your child and take them home.
- Please ensure your child **does not** return in September with an **'extreme' hair style**. We do not allow 'tram lines' or dyed hair at Chetwynd Road.
- Please ensure your child comes to school **without nail varnish or make-up** of any kind.
- Long hair **must be tied back**.

Our uniform consists of:

- A white polo shirt or ordinary white shirt:
- A navy blue sweatshirt, v necked jumper or cardigan with school logo.
- Grey, navy blue or black trousers, skirts or pinafore dresses.

Girls can wear blue and white gingham or striped dresses in the summer and boys may wear grey, navy or black school shorts. Any hair bands or bobbles worn should be blue or black.

There is also a navy blue fleece available, which children may use for outdoor wear or outside games lessons when the weather is cold.

Children should wear sensible flat black shoes. (Plain, sensible sandals may be worn in the summer).

School book bags are used for reading books, personal organisers and homework. Could we ask that the smaller book bags are purchased, not the rucksacks as these take up too much room in the cloakroom,

### P.E. kit.

- White T-shirt or polo shirt with school logo.
- Navy or black shorts
- Navy or black jogging bottoms or tracksuits for winter months
- Plimsolls.

All PE clothes should be stored in a named drawstring PE bag and kept in school (taken home when requiring washing at weekends or holidays) as we often have physical lessons where PE kit is required.

ALL CLOTHING NEEDS TO BE NAMED as staff cannot be responsible for lost items of clothing with no names on.

### New for September 2010 – Pen Licence!

From the beginning of September it will no longer be necessary for you to provide handwriting pens for the children.

We will be starting a new scheme, where children will 'earn' the right to use a pen, by showing good letter formation. They will receive a 'licence to pen' card, which will be formally awarded along with a handwriting pen. The children will personalise their pen by putting a label on it and this will remain in school, for use in their books during the day.

As the pens are disposable, we will replace them when they dry out, however if your child loses their pen then we will ask for 50p towards the cost of replacing it. Please could you encourage your child to take care of it.
